The Fox Valley Metro Police Department Citizens Police Academy is an opportunity for citizens of the Villages of Kimberly & Little Chute and its surrounding communities to become more familiar with the day to day activities of the Police Department.

Citizens will experience first hand what it is like to be a police officer in our growing community.

Each participant will be afforded the opportunity to learn aspects of the police function and gain a basic understanding of the laws, policies, procedures and responsibilities that guide police decision making. Participants will also have the opportunity to ride along with one of our officers and observe first hand the police role and how it is accomplished.

The curriculum for the Citizens Police Academy is designed to be very interactive. The weekly classes involve “hands-on” learning experiences. For example, participants are shown how to dust for latent fingerprints and given the opportunity to do so. Defensive Tactics skills are also demonstrated and participants engage in such things as handcuffing techniques.

As a participant you can expect to receive instructions in a wide variety of topics, to include:

- ✦ Patrol Procedures
- ✦ Vehicle Contacts & Emergency Vehicle Operations
- ✦ Defensive Tactics
- ✦ Firearms
- ✦ Investigations
- ✦ Evidence & Crime Scene Procedures
- ✦ Constitutional Law

Selection Process:

The Citizens Police Academy is on a first come first served basis. Preference is given to Village residents & employees first. People who have no connection to the villages but are interested because their community does not sponsor an academy will also be given an opportunity as long as there are openings in the class.

To qualify, a person will need to be at least 18 years old and have no felony, serious misdemeanor, or domestic violence convictions. The program coordinator will verify all information submitted on the application and participants will be notified by mail as to their status.
